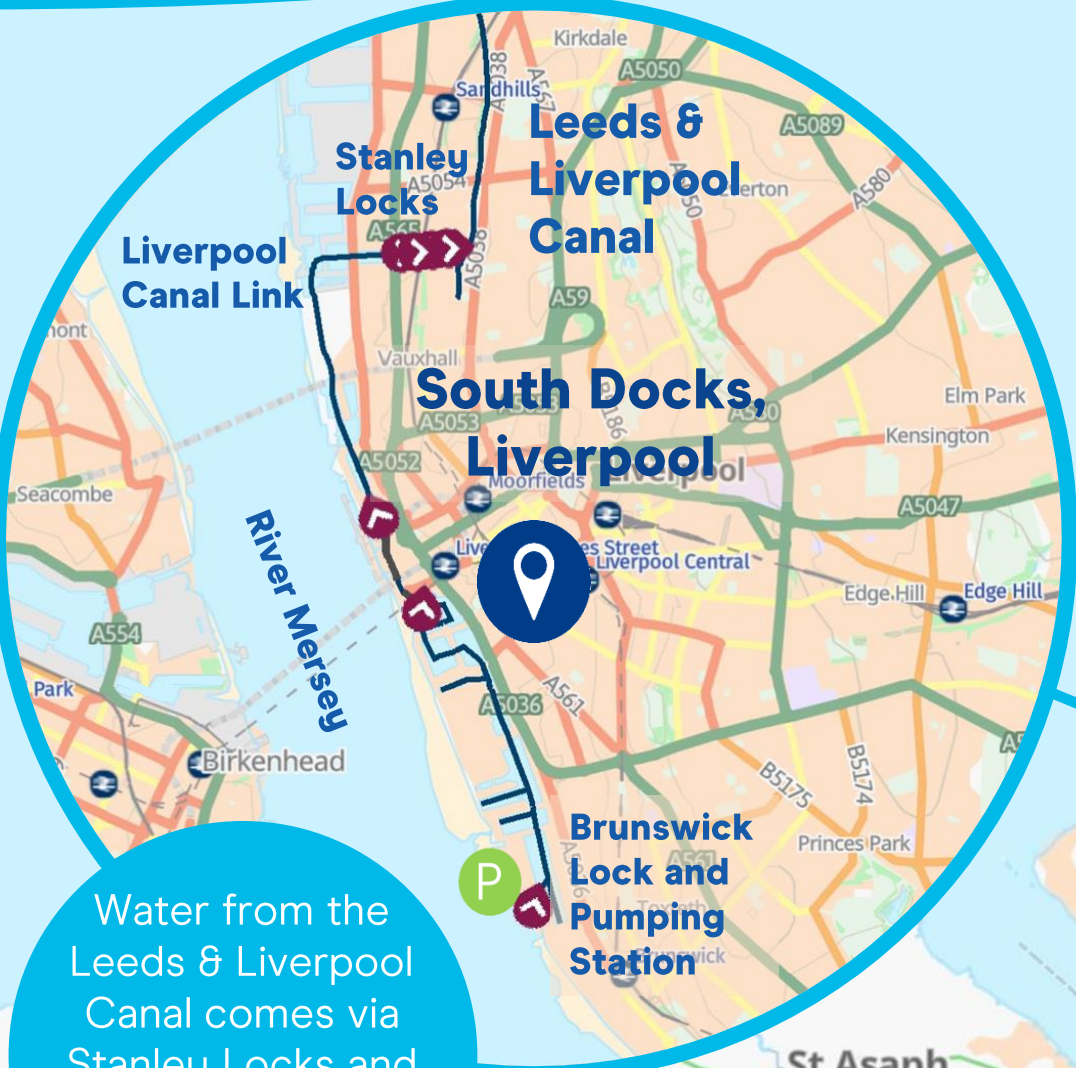


Where does the water come from?

Water in the South Docks at Liverpool comes from the Leeds & Liverpool Canal, and is supplemented by pumping from the River Mersey into Brunswick Dock on the incoming tide



Water from the Leeds & Liverpool Canal comes via Stanley Locks and the Liverpool Canal Link to the South Docks



Seven reservoirs, up to 60 miles away, may supply water to the docks. They are all north east of Blackburn and collect rainwater from the Pennines

Small feeders (diverted streams) also provide some of the water to the Leeds & Liverpool Canal
