



Create and Do: Make a bird bath

You can make a very simple bird bath from plant pots and saucers. There are lots of ideas on the internet to get you started or get creative with your own designs!



You will need:

- Plant pots and saucers
- Strong glue or tile adhesive
- Paints
- Sealer

Top tip

Add stones or pebbles so birds can perch to drink fresh, clean water. This will also enable thirsty bees to drink from the bath, without danger of drowning.

How to make your bird bath

- You can use a single pot or several pots that are different sizes
- If you're using different sized pots, stack them upside down – largest at the bottom
- Make sure you scrub clean the base of the pot before applying the glue
- Be generous with the waterproof glue or tile adhesive
- Make sure the saucer is centred over the pots
- Press the saucer down into the glue and leave it to dry for 24 hours before decorating
- Once you have painted it, add a coat of sealer to protect your design
- You can include a smaller lid, fixed on top of a stone or small pot, as a feeder
